

Can you design and make a model to suggest what Toton's watermill looked like?

Look at the display of information in Toton library or on website totonunearthed.org.uk to discover what facts are known about the mill, the possible plan of the mill and information about the waterwheel.

Consider whether it was a timber building, stone building or brick building or a mix of **materials**.

Create a model mill apply by September 14th 2015

- Work in a group or as in individual
- Use the materials of your choice
- Decorate it with your choice of materials
- Choose a period from Anglo Saxon, Medieval, Tudor, Georgian or Victorian
- Size - no bigger (front to back - depth) 17 inches or 45 cm – width (wheel pit to end) 30 inches or 75 cm

Your mill must have a waterwheel

Give your model a caption to indicate the period portrayed – for example Tudor mill or Saxon mill or 19th century mill.

A group entry must list all the names of the group.

Groups can be 6 people or less - Family groups, School groups of, Brownie, Guide, Scout groups etc
